REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR FY2021 VEHICLE UPFIT EQUIPMENT ROCKINGHAM COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

You are hereby invited to submit proposals for **VEHICLE UPFIT EQUIPMENT**, as specified in the attachments of this Request for Proposal.

The information necessary to complete the proposal is listed below and in the attachment of this invitation.

Proposals must be submitted to the above address **no later than 3:00 p.m. on Monday, August 24, 2020** to be eligible for consideration.

If proposals are being sent via FedEx, UPS, or other mail carrier, please ensure that the mailing envelope/package is clearly marked **RCSO VEHICLE UPFIT EQUIPMENT RFP**. Envelopes/packages not marked with the name of the proposal may be misidentified and will be rejected. Other forms of submission (fax or email) will be rejected. Proposals received after the deadline will be rejected.

An electronic version of your proposal, via CD or flash drive, included inside your sealed bid is welcomed.

Proposal Openings: Proposals will be opened publicly at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Rockingham County Commissioners in the Commissioners Conference Room of the Rockingham County Rehabilitation and Nursing Center, 117 North Road, Brentwood, NH, on **Wednesday, August 26, 2020 at 8:30am**. Proposals will be taken under advisement at that time and will be awarded as soon as a complete review and comparison of the proposals received has been made by the Board of Commissioners.

Proposal Award: The proposal(s) will be formally awarded and announced publicly at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Rockingham County Commissioners held in the Commissioners' Conference Room located in the Rockingham County Rehabilitation and Nursing Center, 117 North Road, Brentwood, NH. Formal notification of proposal award to all proposers will occur immediately thereafter. Information on the award will also be available on the RFP/Bidding section of the County's website at: www.RockinghamCountyNH.org

NOTE: EQUIPMENT REQUESTED IN THIS RFP MUST BE ORDERED AS SOON AS AWARDED TO ENSURE ALL PARTS ARE AVAILABLE FOR INSTALLATION UPON DELIVERY OF VEHICLES.

RFP Prices: RFP prices are to remain in effect for a period of (60) days from opening date of the proposal and are to remain firm once proposal is awarded to the successful proposer(s).

Performance Clause: In the event that the successful awarded proposer/Rockingham County should default in the observance of the stipulations set forth in this Request for Proposal and any attachments thereto and such default is not corrected within 30 days of written notice from either party, the successful awarded proposer/ Rockingham County shall have the option of canceling the proposal.

Contractual Obligations: In the event that contracts for the supply of materials, equipment, or services are required under the bid, the Board of Rockingham County Commissioners reserves the right to review said contracts and amend to comply with county legal requirements prior to signing by the appointed representative of the Board of Rockingham County Commissioners. All contracts entered into by Rockingham County are required to contain Non-Appropriation and Indemnification clauses. Sample language is provided below.

Non-Appropriation

Rockingham County is obligated to pay only such contract amounts that can lawfully be made from funds budgeted and appropriated for that purpose during Rockingham County's then current fiscal year, subject to annual approval by the Rockingham County Delegation. Should Rockingham County fail to budget, appropriate, or otherwise make available funds to make payments under this contract, such contract shall be deemed terminated at the end of the then current term. Rockingham County agrees to deliver prompt notification after any decision to non-appropriation is made, but failure to give such notice will not extend the term beyond such Original or Renewal Term.

Indemnification

To the fullest extent permitted by law, (ORGANIZATION) shall protect, indemnify, save, defend and hold harmless Rockingham County, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees, ("Indemnified Parties"), from and against any and all liabilities, obligations, claims, damages, penalties, causes of action, costs, interest and expenses, including but not limited to reasonable attorney and paralegal fees, which Indemnified Parties may become obligated or suffer by reason of any accident, bodily injury, personal injury, death of person, or loss of or damage to property, arising indirectly or directly under, out of, in connection with, or as a result of this Contract or the activities of (ORGANIZATION) or its agents, employees, contractors or subcontractors, and even if caused in whole or in part by any negligent or intentional act or omission of Indemnified Parties.

In addition, and regardless of respective fault, (ORGANIZATION) shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnified Parties for any costs, expenses and liabilities arising out of a claim, charge or determination that (ORGANIZATION) officers, employees, contractors, subcontractors or agents are employees of the Indemnified Parties, including but not limited to claims or charges for benefits, wages, fees, penalties, withholdings, damages or taxes brought in connection with laws governing workers compensation, unemployment compensation, social security, Medicare, state or federal taxation, and/or any other similar obligation associated with an employment relationship.

(ORGANIZATION'S) obligations to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnified Parties hereunder shall survive the term of this Contract.

Rockingham County shall not be required to defend or indemnify (ORGANIZATION) or its agents, employees, contractors or subcontractors or any professional service provider.

Insurance Requirements

During the life of the contract, the provider shall maintain the following insurance coverage without interruption. The provider must also require its subcontractors to maintain such coverage. Any request for modification of the coverage requirements must be submitted in writing with the proposal, and will be evaluated accordingly.

Workers Compensation Insurance: The provider shall carry workers compensation insurance as required by the State of New Hampshire.

Comprehensive General Liability Insurance: The provider shall maintain comprehensive general liability insurance policy, which includes coverage for contractual liability, in an amount of no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

Motor Vehicle Insurance: The provider shall carry motor vehicle insurance to include bodily injury, property damage, and uninsured motorist, coverage in an amount of no less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per accident.

Provider shall provide an insurance certificate confirming the above insurance coverage. The insurance certificate and the underlying insurance coverage shall be issued by a carrier authorized to do business in the State of New Hampshire and having A.M. Best Company rating of "A" or better.

The provider shall have professional insurance/errors and omissions insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence.


The provider shall file certificates with Rockingham County showing that the above insurance has been purchased.

A 30-day notice is required for cancellation and /or material change of coverage, sent directly to the Rockingham County Commissioners Office at 119 North Road, Brentwood, N.H. 03833.

The Board of Rockingham County Commissioners reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals or parts thereof, to accept the proposal which they deem to be in the best interest of Rockingham County and to waive any bid formality.

Vehicle Equipment RFP Addendum A

Vehicle push bumper with integrated and mounted blue/white led light heads on the front (2 ea.) blue/white emergency lights. Blue/white side mounted led lights. 100 watt siren speaker.

Factory wig-wag headlight feature activated per installation specs (specs provided before installation).

Windshield mounted passenger/driver side interior light-bar, all led modules capable of blue/white.

Siren light control head capable of features similar to the Federal Pathfinder, Whelen Cencom, Sound Off nErgy (Blue Print System), or Code 3 Matrix systems.

Equipment center console capable of mounting the siren light controller, two way radio head, cup holders, arm rest, radar remote and microphone mounts.

Tremco anti-theft system.

Driver/passenger door under mirror led lights blue/white.

Prisoner partition between the front and rear passenger compartment with plexiglass or lexan sliding window.

Metal rear passenger door window guards.

Ventshade style front and rear door window vents.

Rear partition with expanded metal (no plexiglass/lexan) between the rear passenger compartment and cargo area.

LED lights mounted in the side cargo compartment windows
(blue/white)

Rear spoiler mounted light bar with BLUE-RED-BLUE BLUE-RED-BLUE led lights with traffic direction function.

Tailgate mounted LED lights in the area of the license plate blue/red with brake light override.

Led lights in the reverse light blue.

*Installation of the above listed equipment as well as customer supplied two-way radio and antenna, flashlight with charger, rifle and shot gun mounts, charge guard module and decals. A specification sheet will be provided to the installer by the customer for equipment locations prior to installation.

**Siren and light package needs to be able to be programmed for flood lighting for all blue/white heads, alley lighting for side facing led light heads, brake light override for rear facing blue red light heads, blue cruise function for all blue heads, rear traffic direction lighting for the spoiler mounted lights and flash patterns based on whether the vehicle is stationary or moving and the level of daylight at the time.

Vehicle Equipment RFP Addendum B

High beam flashing wig-wag flasher

Windshield mounted passenger/driver side interior light-bar, all led modules capable of blue/white.

Blue/white led light heads mounted on the left and right rear doors facing the sides of the vehicle behind the glass.

Hand held siren light control head capable of features similar to the Federal Pathfinder, Whelen Cencom, Sound Off nErgy (Blue Print System), or Code 3 Matrix systems.

Tremco anti-theft system.

Ventshade style front and rear door window vents.

Window tint applied to top of windshield in front of windshield to conceal emergency light bar and installed at 30% light transmittance on the front passenger and driver door windows. If the vehicles do not have window tint on the rear window or rear passenger doors, tint will be installed at 20% light transmittance.

2 blue led lights (Whelen Vertex style) mounted in the cargo light modules on the top rear of the cab.

2 blue led lights mounted inside the reverse light area.

4 red led lights (1 in each quadrant) of the brake light housing next to the tailgate.

Hard tonneau cover either folding or retractable.

4 grille mounted blue/white led light heads (Whelen ION or similar)

2 front corner surface mounted blue/white led light heads (Whelen Vertex or similar)

Hand held siren light control head capable of features similar to the Federal Pathfinder, Whelen Cencom, Sound Off nErgy (Blue Print System), or Code 3 Matrix systems.

Tremco anti-theft system.

3 compartment prisoner transport module for a 147.6" wheelbase Ford Transit 350 low roof cargo van.

Side door and rear door steps.

4 side facing surface mounted (2 each side) led light heads blue/white.

2 rear facing door surface mounted led light heads blue/white (Whelen M4 or M7 style).

2 blue (Whelen Vertex style) led lights mounted in the reverse lights housings.

2 red (Whelen Vertex style) led lights mounted in the brake light housings.
